



Joining Instructions for RFMA Precision Rifle Level II

Introduction

Welcome to the Precision Rifle level II course. This is a custom designed entry level course offered exclusively by Rob Furlong's Marksmanship Academy, and delivered by world class instructors. This course is an intense, interactive training opportunity for all participants running over a three-day period. The course contains a large amount of information and skills to absorb and process in a short amount of time. You are encouraged to take in as much of the course as possible to gain insight into the methods and techniques taught during this training as well as the teaching philosophy of our instructors. We ask participants to attend course with a professional attitude, and open mind. This will allow for the largest amount of material retention, and provide the best learning atmosphere for everyone.

Students will be required to provide their own transportation, lodging, and meals. Detailed joining instructions will be sent out to each student prior to course with suggestions on the nearest lodging.

Equipment need while on course:

- Rifle capable of shooting 1 MOA out to 1000 meters.
- **400 rounds of match grade ammo** (Must be same type and weight). If attending course with reloaded ammo, the rounds **MUST** be loaded with the same projectile, casing, power, and primer. This is to insure consistency during range applications.
- Kestrel with Applied Ballistics (Recommended) or other ballistic software program.
- Optics with tactical type adjustable turrets, in either MOA or Mils
- Shooting mat of some sort
- Spotting scope with small tri-pod for spotting while lying on the ground
- Small calculator (All smart phones should have a calculator)
- Shooting bag / shooting sock
- Data book (or visit online sites to print off the free data sheets)
- Writing material (pencil, pens & paper)
- Cleaning supplies for your rifle
- Scope mounting tools for your rifle system
- Small flashlight
- Hearing protection
- Eye protection
